The link between personal care products and cancer

Chemical exposure facts

Every day, the average man uses six or more personal care and shaving products. **Exposure: 85 chemicals**

The average woman uses 12 personal care products and cosmetics daily. Teenage girls average 17 products daily. **Exposure: 168 chemicals**¹

These daily exposures matter for a number of important reasons:

First, **only about 11% of the chemicals used in personal care products have been tested for safety and health effects.**²

Second, some of those chemicals tested have been linked to increased risk of cancer, birth defects, endocrine disruption and allergies.³

Third, because no ingredient safety testing is required, personal care products which contain unsafe and untested ingredients are allowed on the market.³ Thus, **one of every five adults are potentially exposed every day to all of the common to personal care product ingredients: hydroquinone, ethylene dioxide, 1,4-dioxane, formaldehyde, nitrosamines, PAHs, and acrylamide.**¹

Chemical exposure facts *continued*

Even though this group of carcinogens can potentially be found in tens of thousands of personal care products, you won't often find them listed on ingredient labels. That's because they are a possible contaminant of a label ingredient and as such, are not required to be listed.³

To better understand why these exposures matter, we need to be aware of how our bodies manage the chemicals at the time of exposure and in the long-term.

Our bodies absorb, accumulate and store chemicals for decades

According to the Environmental Working Group (EWG), a product safety advocacy organization,

"Cosmetic ingredients do not sit tight on the surface of the skin—they are designed to penetrate, and they do".⁴

Biochemist Richard Bence states that up to 60% of certain ingredients in soaps, shampoos, hair products and skin moisturizers are absorbed by the skin. They then flow into the bloodstream, are metabolized through our system while some accumulate in target organs where they can remain for decades.⁴

One study found residues of more than 400 toxic chemicals—including many common cosmetic ingredients—in human tissue. They found industrial plasticizers called phthalates in urine, preservatives called parabens in breast tumor tissue and persistent fragrance components like musk xylene in human fat.⁴
